

Rounds for 12 Students (Also for 11 & 13)

Can be combined with Rounds for 9 or 15 if the students are numerous, and the teacher wishes to divide up the class.

Instructions: The teacher will assign you a letter, and you will work in groups with other letters according to the patterns specified for each round. The teacher will use the following letters:

D-E-G-H-I-J-Q-R-U-W-X-Y

If there are 11 students, there will not be a “D”. If there are 13 students, two students will have the same letter, for instance “Y”, thus forming one group of four in each round.

1st Round	E-J-Q *	G-I-Y	H-R-X	D-U-W
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2nd Round	D-H-Q	E-I-X	G-U-Y *	J-R-W
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3rd Round	I-Q-W	D-J-X *	E-R-Y	G-H-U
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4th Round	D-E-G	H^o-I^o-J	Q-U-R^o	W-X-Y
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For the grading of oral work (presentations):

- * Presence of teacher in the first three rounds
- ^o Presence of teacher in the fourth round in two different groups
