## **Instructions:**

## With "Contracted Forms":

I'd have done it myself, if I'd known you'd forget. You're very forgetful, aren't you? You'd agree on that point, wouldn't you? This time the assignment won't be forgotten, will it? ## With "Full Forms":

The trainee will be checking the software program soon, will he not? Did you not\* tell him about it? If you have not as yet, you had better do so before he has gone. I would have done it myself, if I had known you would forget. You are very forgetful, are you not? \* You would agree on that point, would you not? \* This time the assignment will not be forgotten, will it? We are relying on you, you know!

\*Notice the order of the words in the interrogative full forms
